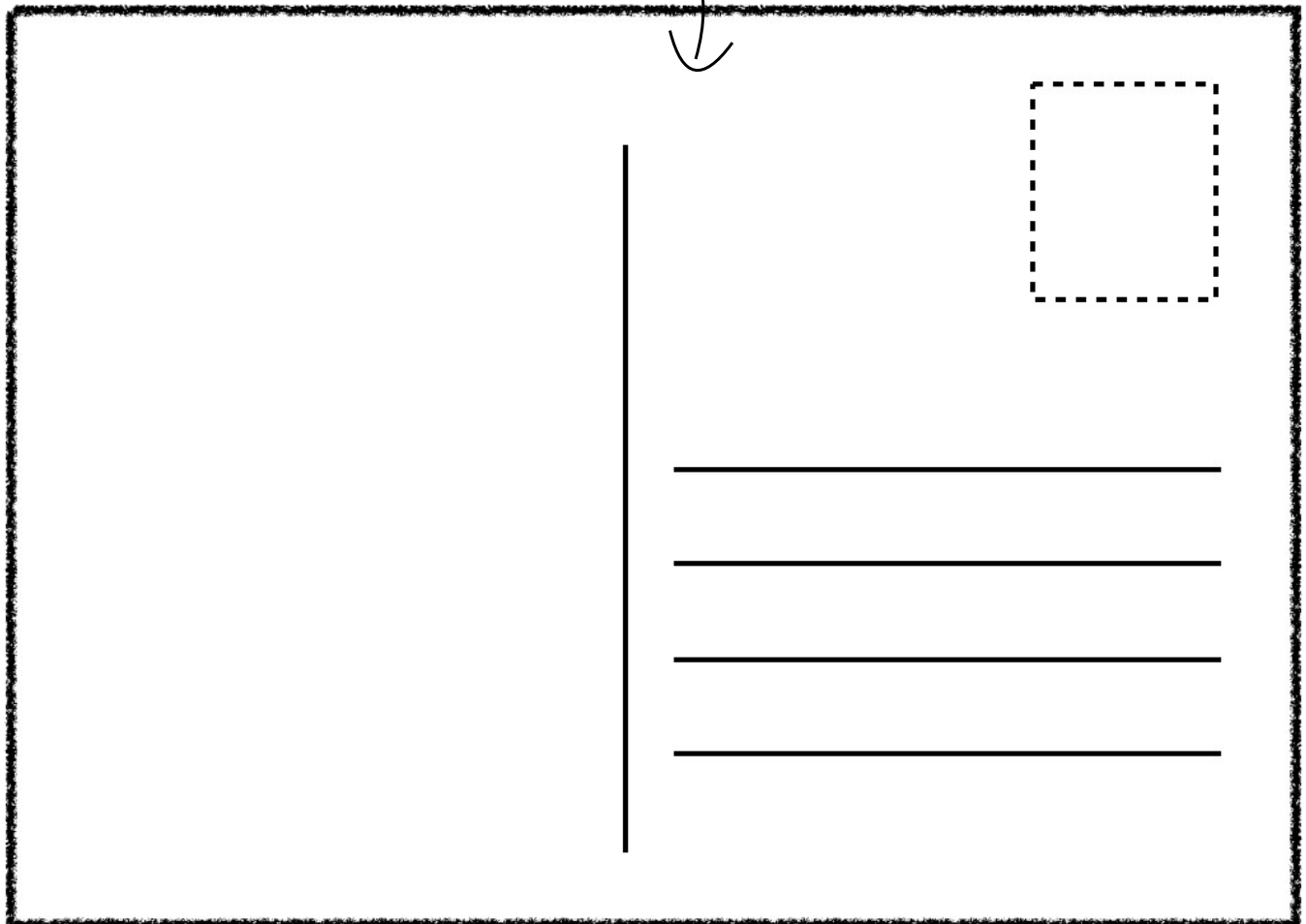
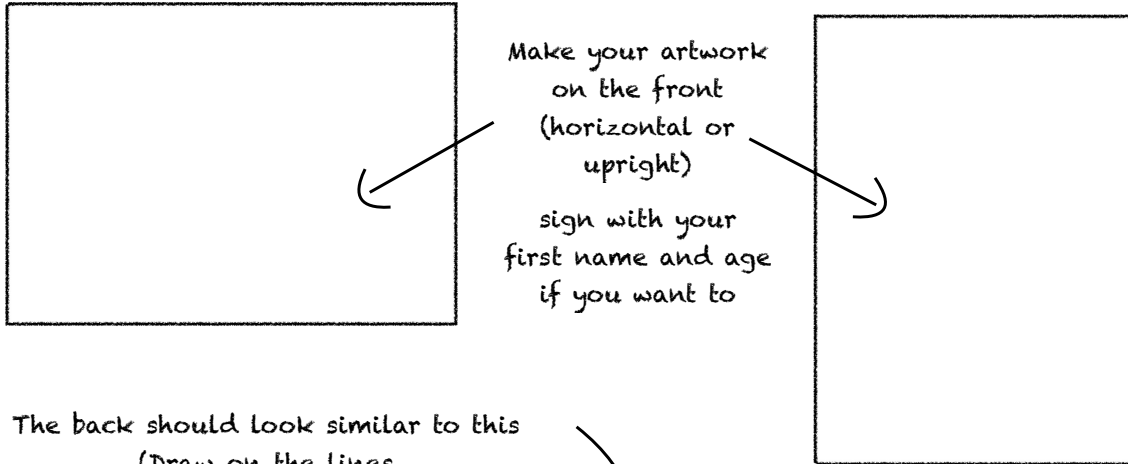
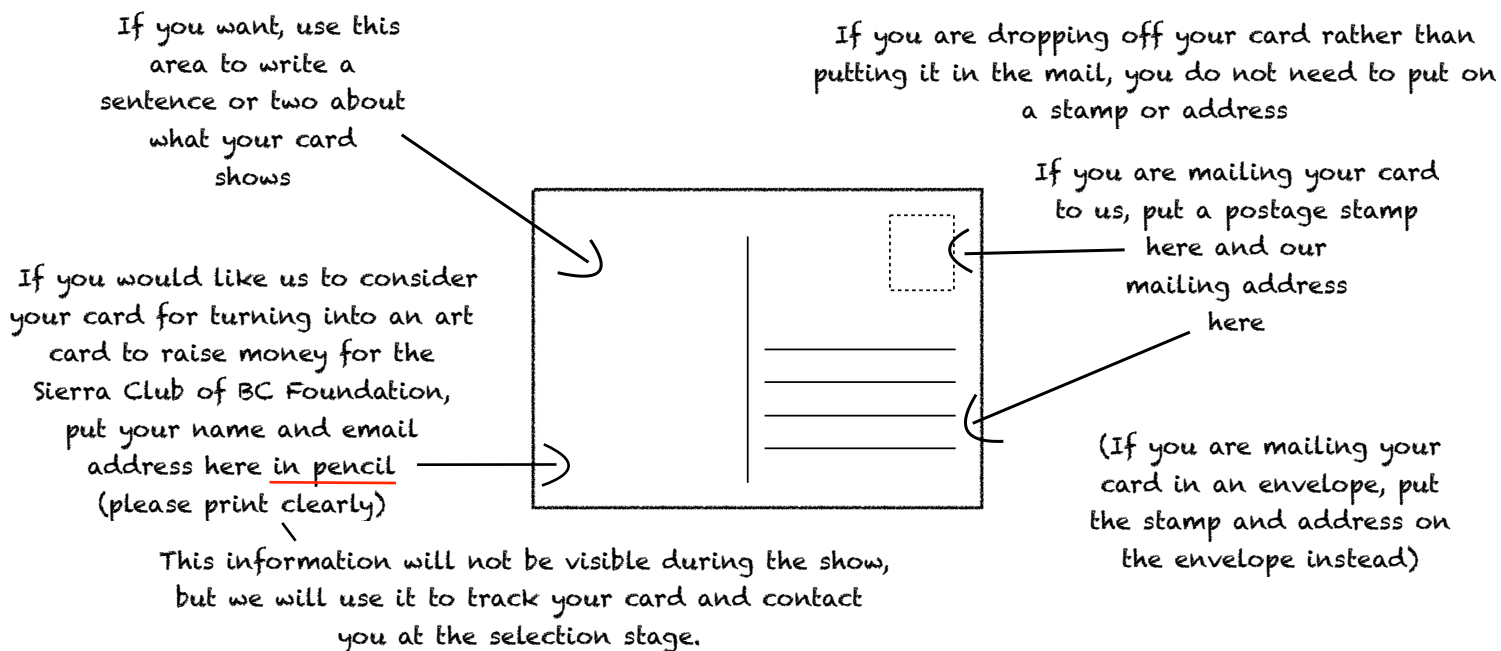


HOW TO MAKE YOUR CARD

- The base of your card can be made of any clean, stiff, paper-like material: card stock, thin cardboard, or a store-bought card. Please use recycled materials if possible.
- Cards can be square or rectangular.
- Maximum dimensions: 6" x 9.5" (we suggest 5" x 7").
- Your card should not fold and be flat enough to mail (in an envelope if necessary).

We are looking into the possibility of making the cards submitted for this project available to other galleries that are interested in running a similar event in their local area. Alternatively, we will try to find a permanent home for them. As a very last resort, we will properly recycle them, so please use recyclable materials.
